How does the adopt-a-worker program work?

- » Gospel Outreach Canada coordinates with Adventist missions, divisions, unions and conferences in the 10/40 Window to identify unentered areas for worker placement.
- » With your commitment to support one or more workers for a year, we'll identify your worker(s) and village(s).
- » We'll update you on the progress of spreading the gospel in that area. You also may receive regional updates of what's happening in the 10/40 Window.

What do I need to do?
