Waiting 15 Years - A story from North Ethiopia

In the remote northwestern part of Tigray, where the rugged mountains kissed the sky and the valleys whispered tales of old, lived a man named Haneytay. For 15 years he had been on a spiritual journey, ever since he first tuned into the soothing voice of Jesus through Adventist World Radio. The teachings resonated with him deeply, yet he found himself isolated, far from any Seventh-day Adventist church.

In his search for community, Haneytay eventually joined a local Full Gospel church. While he appreciated the fellowship, something always felt amiss. He longed for the deeper understanding and connection he had discovered through the radio broadcasts. His heart yearned for a place that truly reflected the teachings he had come to love.

Then, one day last year, an evangelistic team traveled to Shire, led by the field president of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, along with evangelists, officers, and department heads of the North Ethiopia Field. Their mission was to share the gospel and connect with believers in the area. As they journeyed through the hills, they stumbled upon Haneytay's village.

When Haneytay met the team, his heart raced with excitement. They spoke of the very truths he had cherished all these years—the same messages he had absorbed through the radio.

It felt like coming home. Overwhelmed with joy, he shared his story with them, revealing how he had been searching for a true community of faith.

The team welcomed him with open arms and Haneytay wasted no time in sharing this newfound hope with his friends and neighbors. His enthusiasm was infectious, and soon many were curious to learn more about this "true church" he spoke of so passionately.

In a heartfelt ceremony, Haneytay and several of his friends made the decision to be baptized, marking their commitment to their newfound faith. It was a moment of profound joy and fulfillment, a testament to the power of perseverance, faith, and the far-reaching voice of Adventist World Radio.

Haneytay's story is a reminder that the search for truth is never in vain.
